Welcome to The Bobbo 2022




Venue: Start & Finish Karuah Road, Turramurra.

All rides start and finish at Karuah Road Turramurra, just off Eastern Road.

This is approximately 700m from Turramurra railway station. Facilities including registrations, coffee, BBQ, corporate team tents are located at the adjacent Karuah Oval.

The ride will start from Karuah Road and proceed directly onto Eastern Rd by making a right hand turn. Please line up by ride group (colours) as per signs, approaching the start area from Karuah Oval.

To access Karuah Oval and then the start area, please enter from Gilroy Road (off Brentwood Avenue)



City Rail information will be posted a few days before the event

Start Times

Please be ready to start 20 minutes before the advertised time.

104km ride:	6.30am (sharp)
80km ride:	7.00am
57km ride:	7.15am
27km ride:	7.30am (no starts after 7.40am)

If you are in the 104km ride, working lights must be fitted front and rear.

COVID-19

To ensure everyone is safe and secure, do not attend the event if you have any COVID-19 symptoms or feel unwell.



Rider Bibs and Instructions

Bib Mailout

- If you register by midnight on Tuesday 1 September 2022 your Bib and rider instructions will be posted on 3 days later
- Bibs for registrations completed by midnight Monday 6 September will be mailed out 3 days later
- Registrations after midnight 6 September will be available for collection at the registration tent 60 minutes before your ride start.
- If you registered by 6 September and have not received your bib by end of Monday 12 September, please email your name to registration@bobbinheadcycleclassic.org.au. Then collect a replacement bib at Registrations on Karuah Oval 60 minutes before your ride.

Bibs should be attached to the handlebar of your bike using the ties provided.



If you know someone who'd like to take part and hasn't registered yet, they have until 5.00 pm on Saturday 17 Sept to register online.

Registrations will also be available on the day at the Registration Tent from 5.00am up to 30 minutes before the ride (see start times for each ride below).

Bibs for late registrations can be collected at the Registrations Tent at least 30 minutes prior to their ride.



Quiet, please!

Out of respect for the local community, we would really appreciate if you could arrive quietly on Sunday morning. The local residents will be soundly asleep and won't appreciate being woken up by loud voices or car doors and boots being slammed shut.

Parking is available in the Rail Park in Rohini St, Coles Car Park on William Street or the Council Car Park off near Gilroy Lane. If parking on street, please do not block resident access to driveways.

Special 'no parking' zones apply: Eastern Road, northbound lane, between Brentwood Avenue and Chilton Parade; Turramurra Avenue, between Karuah Road and Brentwood Ave; and on Karuah Road, between Turramurra Avenue and Katina Street.



Watch for last minute notices

Urgent messages (eg. cancellation by the authorities due to weather or Covid-19) will be emailed by 5.00am on ride day, or previous evening if possible. You can also visit our website and our Facebook page for updates.

Before the Ride

Have breakfast. Have a big drink of water with breakfast to ensure you are fully hydrated. While we will have muesli bar and bananas at our drink stops, it is important to start the ride with enough fuel in the tank!

Secure your allocated event number to your handlebars with the cable ties provided and write your emergency contact name and phone no. on the back of your bib before attaching it.

Slap on some sunscreen beforehand. The weather forecast for Sunday is sunny so please take precautions

Arrive early at Karuah Oval: Allow sufficient time to get prepared for your allocated start time.



After the Ride

Relax at Karuah Oval: Please join us back at Karuah Oval for some well-earned R&R. There will be amenities, food, drinks, physiotherapy, cycle stalls, and stalls profiling our charity partner and beneficiaries.

Hospitality Marquee If you are part of a Corporate or Social Team of 5 or more and have raised funds of \$1,500 or more you are entitled to enter the Hospitality Marquee where your group can meet and share experiences of the ride.



Please keep up the fundraising - great prizes!

Remember you can still raise funds after the event. We receive a lot of extra funds from riders and their sponsors in the days following the ride – so don't stop when you stop pedalling!

We have prizes for the top individual fundraisers, including a hosted long weekend riding the celebrated Mt Ventoux in France courtesy of Ride &
